You are encouraged to first consult with your local Help Desk at the number provided on this brochure. They, in turn may refer you to the WVNET Help Desk.

## Your Username and Password

When you receive a WVNET modem account, you will be assigned an account **username** and **password**. Always enter in your username and password in lowercase.

When you are asked to provide your username for modem access, enter the modem username assigned to you in lowercase, followed by **@wvnet**. For example: **username@wvnet**.

Note the distinction between your username and password for dial-in access and your username and password for E-mail and other computing accounts. Also be sure to remember your password(s), as there is generally a twenty-four hour delay in resetting them.

\* E-mail accounts are only issued upon request. Your full mail address would be: **username@mail.wvnet.edu**

*Unread POP3 mail to the central-site accounts is automatically discarded after 28 days.*

## Communications Settings

WVNET's Internet dialup modems only support **PPP** (point-to-point protocol). They also use **PAP** (password authentication protocol), which automatically validates your modem userid and password.

WVNET's modems support V.92/V.44 protocol.

## Who Can Use WVNET

Our dialup Internet service is intended to support the missions and goals of higher education, public education, libraries, and state and local government. These missions and goals include education, research, administration, community service, and economic development.

*Commercial, for-profit use is prohibited.*

## Services Provided

The WVNET Internet service is **\$16.95 per month** for **unlimited connect time** to the Internet. Each modem access account may have up to **four personalized email addresses** and corresponding personalized Web directories with 4 MB of space. *(These might instead be provided by your local institution on one of its systems.)*

You may use your WVNET Internet account to:

- ◆ send electronic mail
- ◆ conduct commercial transactions online
- ◆ access the World Wide Web, newsgroups and commercial networks, such as AOL
- ◆ engage in on-line chat sessions
- ◆ transfer files
- ◆ enjoy audio and video programming
- ◆ participate in all legal aspects of the Internet

## How to Get It

You can apply for an account at the local campus of a West Virginia public higher education institution. When you receive your account userid and password, your new account should be ready for immediate use.

*(Note: If you request POP3 mail capability on MAIL.WVNET.EDU, it will not be ready for about 24 hours.)*

## Payment Guidelines

The WVNET Internet service is a monthly subscription service with a flat fee, payable in advance on the first of each month.

## How do I pay?

- **Credit card** -- We currently accept American Express, Discover, MasterCard, and Visa. Automatic deduction will take place on or about the first of each month and will assure continuity of service. An authorization form is included with your coupon booklet.
- **Automatic Debit** – You can pay your monthly \$16.95 account fee through automatic debit to your checking account. Visit [www.wvnet.edu/payment](http://www.wvnet.edu/payment) and print off the automatic debit authorization form.
- **Check** -- You will *not* be billed; you will be provided with payment coupons to include with your check. Payment is due in advance on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. You can pay for several months with 1 check by including the corresponding coupons. Checks must be written for **exactly \$16.95** or multiples thereof.

## How are late payments handled?

An overdue account will be suspended until payment is received.

If payment is received on or before the end of the month, it will be applied to the month in which it is received. However, if a payment is received on or before the end of a month with the coupon for the following month, the account will not be reactivated until the first of that month.

## When is the first payment due?

Payments are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. However, if you sign up for an account between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of a month, your first payment is due for that month and is due by the 25<sup>th</sup>. If you sign up on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> of a month, the remainder of that month is free, and your first payment is due on the first of the following month.

## Can I stop my subscription?

You should not stop and restart the service for short periods of time, such as during holiday breaks. However, if you are a student, you may

stop the service for the summer break.

Students who pay via automatic deduction and who wish to suspend their account for the summer must contact the WVNET central site to have their automatic deduction suspended for the summer.

Students who pay by check and who wish to suspend their account for the summer may do so by not paying for the months they do not wish to use the account.

## Can I get a refund?

No, WVNET does not offer refunds.

## Terms and Conditions

To receive an account, you must agree to abide by WVNET's policies and guidelines related to computer use, your local campus computing policies, applicable network (Internet, etc.) usage guidelines, as well as state and federal laws regarding computer abuse.

- Exercise responsible, ethical behavior when using WVNET's computers, information, networks or resources.
- Do not share your account with others, since accounts are priced for individual use.
- You can have only one account. If your account has been suspended, you must have it reinstated rather than getting a new account.

*Acceptable use violations may result in loss of access privileges, requirements for restitution, suspension or expulsion from school, civil fines and/or judgements, and/or referral to law enforcement agencies for criminal prosecution.*

*WVNET exercises no control over the information available on the Internet.*

## Communications Software

- Recent versions of Microsoft's operating systems come with the necessary software already installed.
- Macintosh System 8.0 or greater already has the necessary software installed. For older systems, disks containing public domain software necessary for Internet access are available from WVNET.

- You may also use any other Internet software from computer stores, bookstores, Web sites, and via mail order.
