Duties and Responsibilities

This position is responsible for supporting state higher education institutions with Oracle and Ellucian Banner products and locally developed applications and interfaces. Installs and maintains Oracle web and development products on a variety of platforms including AIX, Linux and Windows platforms. Develop and maintain interfaces between Banner products and other applications.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities (KSAs)

- Job requires substantial knowledge of database administration and applications using Oracle databases.
 - Must be familiar with the Banner data model, its naming conventions, and have experience extracting and transforming this information for a variety of purposes.
 - Direct experience with the Ellucian Banner data structures is desired and prefer to have experience with other 3rd party applications as well.
- Demonstrated proficiency in administering Banner applications.
- Must have significant experience programming in PL/SQL and be able to quickly and efficiently produce both SQL queries, and custom PL/SQL code.
 - Demonstrated proficiency in at least one higher level programming language.
- Demonstrated proficiency in problem solving, system analysis, and design. Able to collect
 information and data through research and customer interactions. Able to work on multiple
 demands concurrently and manage projects with short deadlines.
- Working knowledge of the Linux operating system required, proficiency in Unix/AIX desired.

- Experience in Tomcat application management strongly desired, experience in Oracle Fusion Middleware / WebLogic preferred, particularly in Ellucian Banner environment.
